END DISCRIMINATION AGAINST WOMEN AND GIRLS

In the annual report for quality of education an information about women's application rate, acceptance/entry rate and study completion rate at the university is measured.

VoISU Open Doors Day annually holds events aimed at women's professional orientation including talks with professors and directors of institutes where women are underrepresented (for example institute of mathematics and informational technologies and institute of priority technologies).

Men and women, who study at VoISU, have equal power and equal opportunities for financial independence, education, and personal development. University disposes separate men and women changing room and restrooms. University also provides financial help for just-married couples or women who have recently had a child. University provides free mother-and-child rooms for students and staff (recent mothers). Women who study or work at VoISU can get a free mental support from university's psychologist and also financial support.

Students and employees of VoISU are obliged to observe the VoISU Ethics Code which excludes any kind of gender discrimination.

VoISU annually holds different conferences dedicated to women's role in modern society with the wide participation of female students and staff.

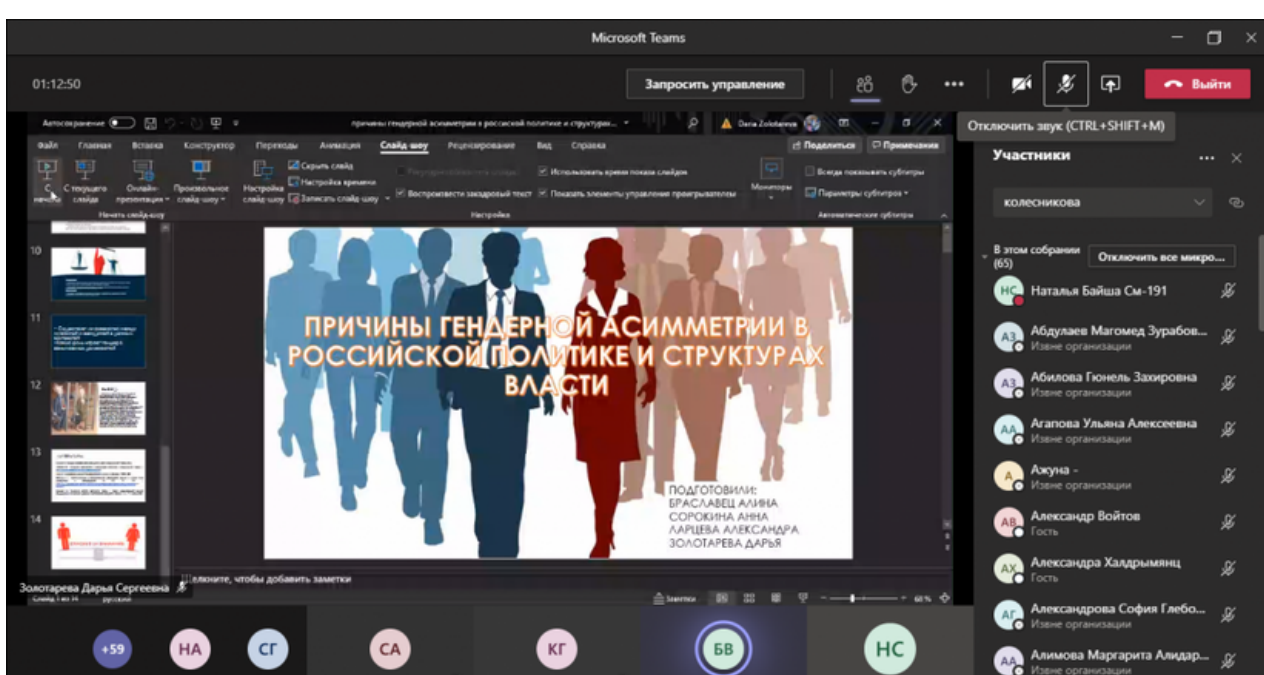


Number of women starting a degree:
